VISUAL ANALYSIS: ruby with violet reflections

OLFACTORY ANALYSIS: blueberries, blackberries, black pepper, scent of orange and violet

GUSTATIVE ANALYSIS: nice alcohol and good softness; the tannins are really interesting and the final is blueberries flavoured; the gustative aromatic persistency is about 4/5 seconds

WINE-FOOD COMBINATION: risotto con broccoli (Italian recipe)

- The alcoholic dryness of the wine is counterweighing the succulence of the risotto
- The astringency of the tannins is counterbalancing the succulence of the risotto
- The structure of the wine is pairing the structure of the recipe
- The gustative-aromatic persistence of the wine is matching the gustative-olfactory persistence of the recipe
