At the visual analysis, it demonstrates to be brilliant and intense as usual for a spirit; as regards the chromatic tones, it is gold color with straw yellow highlights.

At the olfactory analysis, the nose is intense and complex, and the perfumes, which compose the olfactory bouquet, are all clear, neat and limpid. As the description of the olfactory sensations, it is possible to identify caramel, honey, wood, toasted wood, varnish, medicine, soap, talc, banana, coconut, plum, rum banana cream, yellow peach, vanilla, curry, soap, talc and chamomile.

At the gustative analysis, alcoholic sensation in the central part of the tongue and slight salivation in the lateral areas; the final is with flavors of banana, coconut and plum.

At the retro-olfactory analysis, the alcoholic note remains consistent and easily noticeable, but not so stable in the sense that the intensity is not strong as at the beginning; the retro-olfactory sensations are summarized with just a dominant flavor, represented by a lovely bitter sensation.

The gustative aromatic persistency is about 36/37 seconds.

**OPINIÓN PERSONAL:** interesting bouquet at the nose, but almost pure alcohol at the taste level, with a strange and easily perceptible salivation; at the gustative analysis, some fruit aromas are released in correspondence with the nose but unfortunately are not confirmed in the retro-olfactory exam, where the final aroma is the respectable and dominant bitter sensation, as to suggest a meditative tasting with just the whisky.
